S. Bruce Butrym Jr., Captain US Navy, Retired, was born in McKeesport, PA, February 24, 1929, and died, Friday, July 30, 2004, at his home, with family, in Austin, TX. Captain Butrym was always involved in his boys' sports teams, Little League, football, swim teams and golf. He loved working with kids. He loved the Navy. He was a member of the American Legion Post 326 at Onion Creek, Austin, TX. His last wish was to be buried near his son, Ken, in Quantico, VA, National Cemetery.
